

WHAT TO EXPECT ON JANUARY 24TH

Upon arriving at the Capitol, participants are encouraged to stop by the Welcome Room (E1.018) to pick up:

- T-shirts and caps that were pre-ordered (we are not allowed to sell anything on Capitol grounds)
- Info sheet on days' activities with summary of legislation priorities and talking points for meeting with legislators.
- Special items to be delivered to both your house rep and senator that show support for the election legislation.

The Legislative Briefing is from 10:00 am - 3:00 pm. The meeting room E1.016 holds approximately 85 people. An overflow room will hold another 70. Ideally, grassroots activists will watch the program on the closed-circuit TV in their legislators' offices. We want to make sure the staffers and the members are tuned into our program. Being in their offices will drive home the point. We encourage attendees to call their legislators in advance of the event to make appointments to meet with them.

The Senate will hold a session from 11:00 am - 12:00ish, so the closed-circuit viewing will not be available to our Briefing during that time. We will have live streaming on a Rumble Channel. Check back on the website Tuesday morning for the Rumble Channel name.

Great news! The Brunson Brothers will be in the Rotunda from 12:00 pm - 1:00 pm. Stop by and meet them!

We will hold a Prayer Rally on the South Capitol steps from 2:00-5:00 pm. Some of the speakers from the inside Briefing will come out to the steps to speak as well. Lara Logan, the Brunson Brothers, Major Keith Blandford, South Carolina National Guard, will be featured guests as well as pastors, civic leaders, and elected officials from across the State. Be careful when walking around the scaffolding on the South Capitol steps.

T-shirts (\$15) and caps (\$18) with our logo on it will be available in E1.018. Lapel buttons are free for the asking. We want everyone to dress out so we can increase our visible presence. Donations can be made on TexasFirst.org and are greatly appreciated.

Some counties will have busses going to Austin for this event. Contact your local GOP for more information.

Lunch will be on your own at the Capitol cafeteria or at the place of your choosing. No set lunch break is scheduled during the Briefing.

The Legislative Briefing will be recorded and live streamed. The Prayer Rally will be live streamed.

The event is open to the public at no cost. No RSVP is needed.
